

Lecturer, Engineering Communication Program

The Faculty of Applied Science and Engineering at the University of Toronto invites applications for the continuing position of Lecturer/Senior Lecturer in the Engineering Communication Program (ECP). The position of Lecturer is subject to review in the third year. In the fifth year of service, Lecturers will be reviewed and a recommendation made with respect to promotion to the rank of Senior Lecturer. Anticipated start date is July 1, 2010.

We are inviting candidates with a strong commitment to Engineering Communication and a deep knowledge of written, oral and visual communication practice. Candidates must have an outstanding academic record and evidence of excellent teaching ability.

The successful candidate will work as part of a team to develop and support an integrated communication program for undergraduate engineers. The overall portfolio will include co-teaching (with engineering faculty) courses that are integrated engineering design/engineering communication courses or teaching communication courses partnered with specific engineering courses, overseeing the design and delivery of all communication curriculum for a specific department or departments, tutoring one-to-one in the Engineering Communication Centre as well as delivering single workshops on selected topics. Salary to be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Candidates must have a PhD (or Master's Degree combined with equivalent experience) in the field of Technical Communication or in a related area (such as, but not limited to, Applied Linguistics, Digital Media, Drama, English, Rhetoric, Professional Communication, Second Language Education or Technical Communication) as well as experience working in an engineering context. Essential for this position are the ability to work in teaching teams, identify and solve curriculum challenges and design innovative instructional programs.
